Attention All Interested Parties!

The National Cave Rescue Commission (NCRC) will be having elections in February 2019 for the following positions. If you are interested in running for any of the positions, please complete an application packet and return to me by January 31, 2019 so I may distribute to the Board prior to the meeting. Requirements for candidates include being a NSS member in good standing (and will remain Society members for their entire term) and interest in furthering cave rescue training at both a Regional as well as National level.

Regional Coordinators

The NCRC is led by a Board of Regional Coordinators (BORC), representing each of the 10 NCRC regions (Caribbean, Central, Eastern, North Eastern, Pacific Northwest, Rocky Mountain, South Central, Southeastern, Southwestern, and Western) as well as a National, Training, Medical, and Diving Coordinators. Positions are voted upon by the BORC, however are subject to approval by the NSS Board of Governors (BOG). The Regional Coordinators meet in person during our Winter Meeting as well as participate in conference calls throughout the year as the need arises. The following Regional Coordinator positions are up for election:

- South Eastern Regional Coordinator Alabama, Florida, Georgia, South Carolina, Tennessee
- Caribbean Regional Coordinator Cuba, Mexico (training only), Puerto Rico, Virgin Islands,
 Central America and northern South America
- South Central Regional Coordinator Arkansas, Louisiana, Kansas, Mississippi, Mexico (rescue only), Oklahoma, Texas
- Rocky Mountain Regional Coordinator Colorado, Idaho, Montana, North Dakota, Nebraska, South Dakota, Utah, Wyoming

Training Officer

The Training Coordinator will oversee the NCRC's cave rescue training activities and implement training policies and procedures as developed by the BORC. The Training Coordinator is also a member of the BORC and is also subject to the approval by the NSS BOG.

Qualified candidates will work on a committee that entails monthly conference calls, working on curriculum as assigned by the Training Coordinator, twice annual travel to the in-person work weekends. Interested candidates should have the familiarity with the NCRC and its curriculum, have

good follow-through with work assignments, have a working knowledge of Word and PowerPoint, and have good team dynamics.

Your application packet should include a letter stating which position you are running for, your caving and/or cave rescue experience(s), other types of training, certifications, or skills would benefit the NCRC, and what you would like to see accomplished during your tenure. While not required, if running for a Regional Coordinator or Training Officer position, letters of support from within the Region will help the Board with the decision making process. In lieu of a letter/packet, you may appear in person during our Winter Meeting. Please contact me for dates and locations.
